Pendulum Assembly

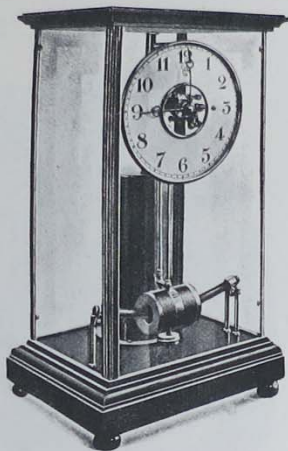

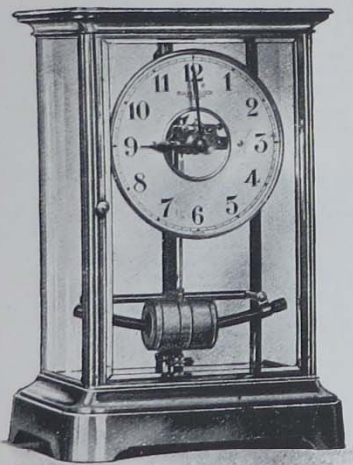

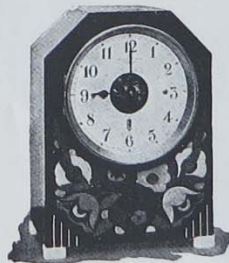

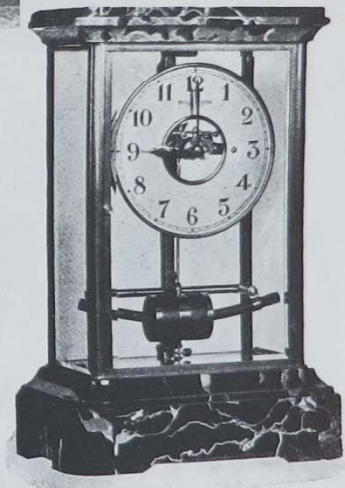
